

RAS Request for Support form

The RAS network is designed to support you to develop professionally within the contemporary dance sector in Moray, the Highlands, the Western Isles, and up to Shetland. We are able to offer both in-kind and financial support to individuals engaged with contemporary dance practice¹. With support from Creative Scotland, we have £9,500 of funding available to distribute to the network. We are aiming to allocate approximately £2,375 in each quarter of the financial year. During each 6-month periods, funding will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis, with an intention to review requests of over £200 every 3 weeks. Once the £2,375 has been allocated, we are unlikely to accept any further requests for financial support until the next quarter, though will consider applications on an exceptional basis.

The request form is not mean to be lengthy or time-consuming. A short paragraph is all that is required as an answer to the text-based questions. If you would like to discuss the process in advance of submitting, please contact us on info@dancenorth.scot.

Eligibility criteria

We only accept requests for support from RAS members.

Enquiries are welcome from individuals engaged with contemporary dance practice, who are interested in developing professionally within the sector, and who have an existing relationship with Moray, the Highlands, the Western Isles and/or Shetland. This relationship could include being resident within the region of having established working partnerships with regional organisations, venues and/or groups. Eligible individuals must demonstrate a commitment to engaging with the region, be it with people, organisations, the environment, history or culture.

You are eligible to make multiple requests throughout the year. If funding is short, however, we may prioritise new applicants if you have already received support from the programme.

What we can support

- Training
- Attendance at events
- Travel
- Memberships
- Promotion of work
- In some instances, venue hire
- Mentoring
- Skills sharing
- Peer support
- Partnership building

What we can't support

- Direct costs associated with residencies
- Commissioning
- Costs associated with the direct creation of work

Decision-making process

Up to £200 - One member of the Dance North team will review your submission and will authorise the expenditure, if eligible and available. These requests will be reviewed as and when they are received.

£200 - £1,500 - Two members of the Dance North team will review your submission. These requests will be reviewed every three weeks.

More than £1,500 - A member of the RAS network will be invited to join two members of the Dance North team to review your submission. These requests will be reviewed every three weeks.

In-kind requests - Two members of the Dance North team will review your submission. These requests will be reviewed every three weeks.

We aim to inform you of the outcome within one month of submitting your request. If your request is time sensitive, please e-mail info@dancenorth.scot in advance of submission to alert us.
